

# Teryx4 Rear Bench (A3652)

## Install Instructions



**Read through all of the instructions completely before beginning the install.**

**Parts Included:**

- 1, 52" wide rear bench with 3 hoop headrests
- 2, Mounts for Teryx4 rear bench (Driver/Passenger)

**Hardware Required:**

- 2, 3/8" x 1" bolts
- 2, 3/8" x 3" bolts
- 8, Washers
- 4, Locking nuts

**Tools required:**

- Phillips head screwdriver
- Ratchet and open end wrenches

**Remove all parts from the box and unwrap completely using the packaging to lay out the pieces.**

**Time:**

Approx 30 minutes.

1. Remove the rear bucket seats and belts. Retain the bucket seat frame bolts for later.
2. Remove the Phillips head screws holding the black plastic piece, this is the large plastic part under the bucket seats. The rear cup holders are part of this piece.
3. Remove the plastic piece and cut the plastic as shown in picture A to within 1.5" of the floor and rear wall.
4. Reinstall the plastic base.
5. Thread the harnesses through the lap belt and shoulder harness slots in the bench seat.
6. Flip the bench seat over and install the lap belts to the mounts on the brackets that flare out.
7. Install the seat mounts to the seat, tighten the rear bolts until they are snug but not tight and the mounts pivot, tighten the front bolts finger tight
8. Install the seat, harness, mount assembly into the Teryx 4, use 3 people for best results
9. Remove the forward mounting bolts and lift the front of the seat. The seat will pivot up on the rear bolts and allow room to work underneath.
10. Align the seat mount slots with the original bucket seat mounting holes in the Teryx 4 chassis,  
(Each Teryx 4 may be slightly different, it may be necessary to loosen the rear bolts a little to adjust the alignment)
11. Use the original bucket seat frame bolts with supplied washers to bolt the seat mounts to the Teryx 4 chassis
12. Tighten the rear bolts holding the seat mounts to the seat
13. Push the front of the seat down and align front bolt holes
14. Install front bolts and tighten
15. Install shoulder harness straps to the rear Tery 4 cage cross bars. Be sure to follow the instructions provided with the harnesses carefully using the proper wrap around technique.
